Please follow the current government guidelines on social distancing.




Climb Step Mountain

Climb to the top of step mountain to the pond! If you can, keep going on the steps around the left of the pond.



Mandala means 'circle' with a symmetrical pattern starting from the centre. You can make one using natures' gems from the woodland floor like leaves, sticks, pebbles and flowers. Don't be afraid to get creative!





Get up at sunrise to hear the birds

Sunrise is the best time to hear all the birds singing at once. Listen out for the drumming sound of a woodpecker and the 'Tea-cher! Tea-cher!' of a great tit.



What shapes can you see in the sky? Maybe you can create a story out of what you see. Lie down in the grass in the meadow and observe.





Mix together some water in soil to create mud! Why not decorate your pie with some

pebbles? Remember it is not a pie for tasting and be sure to wash your hands through afterwards!
