

MAKE A CROWN

People have used nature to make decorations for many years. Can you create your own crown from the gems and treasures you find at Seven Lochs?



You will need

- 2 x A4 paper
- Glue or sticky tape
- A small container or bag to collect natural items



Keep in mind

- Wash your hands after handling natural items
- Avoid pulling leaves or flowers off of plants or disturbing an area too much
- If you aren't sure what something is, best not to touch it


Activity Sheet

Put two sheets of A4 paper next to each other with the short ends touching. Tape them together along the short ends.





Fold the long edge of paper up by about 10cm. Tape the ends of this new fold to create a pocket.





Place the paper around your head, with the pocket at the bottom. Tape the ends together to fit your head.





Now you have made your crown you can decorate it with the natural materials you collected! Slide them into the pocket and secure them in place with tape or glue.
