



## Session Outline: Winter crafts activity day: Rec & KS1

Learning objectives	Session structure	
<p>Reflect on seasons, midwinter, what midwinter is.</p> <p>Learn about the natural resources that can be used all around us in nature.</p> <p>Harvest resources and use them to make things with.</p> <p>Making a connection with nature in everyday life.</p> <p>Participating in making things – practical skills, and using fine motor skills.</p>	<p><b>Introduction</b>  <b>10am - Welcome to centre</b>            We play a game to help the children become comfortable outside and then go to the round house to look at a book about seasons.</p> <p><b>10:30am – Divide into three groups to begin craft activities.</b></p> <p><b>Winter Crafts:</b> Children will have a go at craft activities such as...</p> <p><b>Owls</b>            We read owl babies and then make owl models</p> <p><b>Gnomes</b>            The children wake up tiny gnomes and make clothes for them to wear</p> <p><b>Winter Walk</b>            We explore the site to look for signs of winter and either make a sticky postcard, a leaf crown or a mobile using things that we gather.</p> <p><b>12.00 Lunchtime</b></p> <p><b>1.00 Woodland play session with the chance to</b></p> <p><b>2.30 Depart for school</b></p>
